Over the past twelve years, Campfire! Bible Camp, in co-operation with the St. David's Inner City Mission and Streetlight Ministries, has been involved in outreach projects in Hamilton's northeast end. Many of the children that we have worked with during this time come from broken homes or environments of poverty or neglect. Most of them will not have an opportunity to escape the smog and the heat of the downtown core this summer.

We have invited them to a week of camp during our Campfire! 2009 summer programs. We want to provide them with a much-needed holiday, full of positive encouragement and new experiences. More importantly, we want to bring to them the message of salvation and peace through Jesus Christ.

Campfire! Bible camp is a Christian, non-profit overnight camp operated by members of the Canadian Reformed churches of Ontario. Campfire! is a registered charity and operates in advisory consultation with the Cornerstone Canadian Reformed Church at Hamilton.

Our mission is to serve God through our camp. Our purpose is to teach children about God and the Bible. Our mandate is to provide children with an enjoyable and spiritual holiday in a rural setting, full of new and challenging activities, which promote an active faith in God, responsible behaviour and the development of Christian life skills.

Our camp is open to all children. This summer we will be operating an eight-week program, including full week camps for teens (ages 13-17), children (ages 8-12) and a mini-camp for "sprouts" (ages 5-7). As part of this summer's program, we will be inviting over 100 underprivileged children from Hamilton's inner city to participate in our camp on a no-cost basis. Most of these children are referred to us by the Inner City Mission of the St. David's Presbyterian Church, located near the intersection of Burlington and Wentworth Streets in Hamilton's East End, and by Streetlight Ministries, an urban mission work project operated in Hamilton by the Ancaster and Burlington South Canadian Reformed churches. All other children are asked to pay a suggested participation fee. However, in situations of *bona fide* need, participation fees are waived or reduced, as required.
