2021 was another challenging yet rewarding year for Campfire! After hoping, and praying, and plenty of planning, and more praying, we were so thankful to be able to hold in-person Camp this past summer!

It was a beautiful time, where we were able to share the Gospel with 227 campers, as well as counsellors, kitchen volunteers, and many others. Many thanks to our staff and volunteers for their devotion and sacrifice! We could not do it without you.

Financially speaking, Campfire had a difficult year. Due to lower enrollment because of public health limits, a cancelled week due to a positive COVID case, and some unforeseen property costs, we ended December in a \$75,000 deficit. Because of the support of our generous donors, we were able to decrease that deficit to \$45,000! We THANK our supporting churches and individual donors, for giving of your financial gifts and assisting us in spreading the gospel for another year to these precious children. Campfire is dear to the hearts of many. When the future looked bleak, God lifted us as Board and Summer Camp Committee and gave us the strength to go on.
